## **ATROPINE SULFATE 1% OPHTHALMIC SOLUTION INSTRUCTIONS**

This medication is used to reduce or help prevent tracheal (throat) congestion. Although they are eye drops, you will be giving them under the tongue, and they will absorb through the oral mucosa (mouth). You will place the appropriate number of drops (according to MD order) under the tongue. The usual dose is 3-5 drops every 1 hour as needed. Your nurse can demonstrate this for you.
