Kimberly Chose to leave her dream job in television and film to discover the authentic stories at the bedside of the dying. Working in hospice was to be temporary until she built relationships in the film industry, but this job spread over 17 years. It never crossed Kimberly's mind that her true calling would find her and lead to unexpected and bold intentions to become a leader in the death positive movement happening in the United States today.

Since her book, *Bridging the Gap*, was published last year, Kimberly is onto her next adventure – speaking throughout the United States.
