## Accolades & Accomplishments



### Digital Therapy

We introduced our newest complementary therapy, Mynd Immersive, a senior-friendly virtual reality platform used with patients as a form of Digital Therapy. Patients can choose from 100 virtual experiences, from watching a Broadway musical to touring war memorials in Washington D.C.

### Best of Kenosha

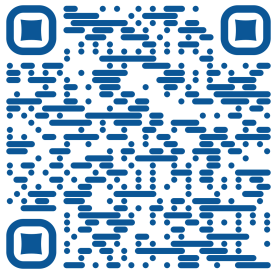
### Joint Commission
